



End User Notice - HP ProCurve Non Retail Encryption Products

The HP ProCurve product that you have purchased contains cryptography and is subject to certain deployment restrictions. These restrictions arise from the fact that this product is subject to U.S. export regulations and is not considered to be “retail” by these regulations.

European Union member countries: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, and United Kingdom, plus Australia, Canada, Czech Republic, Hungary, Japan, New Zealand, Norway, Poland and Switzerland, United States

(b) this term does not include the following public entities: utilities (including telecommunications companies and Internet service providers); banks and financial institutions; transportation; broadcast or entertainment; educational organizations; civil health and medical organizations; retail or wholesale firms; and manufacturing or industrial entities not engaged in the manufacture or distribution of items or services controlled on the Wassenaar Munitions List.

Export, re-export or transfer of these products to any party in Cuba, Iran, Iraq, Libya, North Korea, Sudan, Syria requires prior U.S. government export authorization.
